RULES OF CONDUCT AND RELEASE

In line with the new General Data Protection Law (Brazilian Federal Law nº 13.709/2018), this document must be completed and signed by <u>all those involved with the project</u>:

- The mentor (and co-mentor, if there is one);
- · All the finalists;
- All the guardians of the students under 18.

Note: digitally certified signatures are also valid.

1. Rules of conduct:

- 1.1 All MOSTRATEC participants MUST follow the Rules of MOSTRATEC which are available at https://www.mostratec.com.br/en/rules-of-mostratec/:
- 1.2 The use of tobacco products, alcoholic beverages and/or other types of drugs is prohibited in the fair and in the places where related events happen, anywhere near those sites and at the hotels.
- 1.3 If it is a group project, one of the finalists must ALWAYS be at the booth throughout the visiting hours. If the project is individual and the exhibitor needs to leave the booth, the absence has to be justified.
- 1.4 The finalists must keep the booth clean and tidy.
- 1.5 The finalists must strictly observe the schedules set out in the **MOSTRATEC Program**, as well as answering the extra calls for evaluation purposes.
- 1.6 Any situation that is not covered by this document will be reported to the SRC or to the Health and Safety Subcommittee

Note: The non-observance of the Rules of Conduct will be analyzed by the SRC and may result in loss of points or in disqualification according to the procedures below:

- a) written warning;
- b) loss of 10 (ten) points in the final score if what was stated in the written warning is not observed;
- c) Loss of 30% in the final score in cases of recidivism.

2. Intellectual property:

Scientific misconduct, academic plagiarism (copy of a Project or of part of it) and / or data from a project used without written authorization will fail to qualify for the competition.

3. Responsibility for belongings:

The finalists are responsible for their belongings. During public visitation, it is advisable to take precautions to protect the belongings to avoid thefts, losses and damages. MOSTRATEC is not responsible for any case of theft, loss or damage to the finalists' belongings.

Note: MOSTRATEC maintains a security system that protects the projects before and after the fair scheduled hours. Nonetheless, we recommend that finalists take away valuable items daily at the end of the fair.

4. Media Concession:

- **4.1.** The finalists and their mentors (and co-mentors) allow the Central Committee to use information (photos, videos, folders, etc.) exhibited in the booth for publicity purposes related to MOSTRATEC;
- **4.2.** The press is allowed to use data or images for publicity purposes;
- **4.3.** The finalists should cooperate with the press giving information with the purpose of promoting the fair and their projects.
